As each of these grants and programs have specific guidelines for eligibility and rules regarding the purchase of Health Information Technology (HIT) hardware and software, this document provides guidance on how HIT purchases charged against these grants and programs may be used to optimize all the HIT funding. The information provided in this guidance may be subject to change based on changes in contract language.
