Recovery Plus Lancaster Recovery and Treatment Center is a clinic service that provides a broad range of mental health services to meet the needs of adults with a diagnosis of mental illness.

We take a person-centered holistic approach to recovery. We are not just treating an illness. Rather, we work with individuals to rebuild a foundation which will sustain lasting recovery and an improved quality of life.



Our Services

We provide a combination of diagnostic and treatment services for individuals with mental illness. We also provide supportive services for families and significant others.

Services include: individual psychotherapy, medication therapy, medication education, psychological assessments, symptom management, vocational counseling, health screening, and peer support.

Location/ Hours of Operation

Lancaster RTC is located at 525 Pavement Road in the Lancaster Town Center.

The site is handicapped accessible and has ample parking. Assistance in accessing Medicaid Taxi is provided to eligible individuals.
