

# PSYCKES-Medicaid Release Notes – Release 5.0.0

## Clinical Summary

### New Alerts & Incidents Section

A new “Alerts & Incidents” section in the Clinical Summary displays information from the New York State Incident Reporting and Management System (NIMRS) as well as Medicaid service information related to self-inflicted harm or poisoning and suicidal ideation or attempts, if applicable for the recipient. The alerts and incidents section will be updated weekly. The specific alert/incident types and their data source include:

Alert/Incident Type	Data Source
Suicide Attempt	NIMRS
Suicide Attempt	Medicaid
Suicidal Ideation	Medicaid
Self-Inflicted Harm/Injury	Medicaid
Self-Inflicted Poisoning	Medicaid

Incidents from NIMRS will include the date of the incident, name of the provider agency and program that reported the incident, and severity and harm of the incident. Alerts from Medicaid data will include the date of the service and name of the provider agency and program billing for the treatment.

### Health and Recovery Plan (HARP) Status Updated

The “HARP Status” information located in the heading portion of the Clinical Summary includes detailed HARP enrollment information and will be updated weekly as eligible individuals become enrolled in a HARP Managed Care plan and assessments are conducted for Home and Community Based Services (HCBS). The following “HARP Status” categories will be available in the Clinical Summary if applicable for the recipient:

- Enrolled without HCBS Eligibility (H1)
- Enrolled with Tier 1 HCBS Eligibility (H2)
- Enrolled with Tier 2 HCBS Eligibility (H3)
- SNP HARP-Eligible without HCBS Eligibility (H4)\*
- SNP HARP-Eligible with Tier 1 HCBS Eligibility (H5)\*
- SNP HARP-Eligible with Tier 2 HCBS Eligibility (H6)\*
- Eligible Pending Enrollment (H9)
- Not HARP-Eligible

\*For individuals in a SNP Managed Care plan, detailed HARP enrollment information will only be available if the client signed a PSYCKES consent form.

## Recipient Search

### New Alerts & Incidents Filter

The “Alerts & Incidents” section in Recipient Search allows users to conduct a group search to identify all clients who meet criteria for one or more of the alerts and incidents described above:

- Alerts & Incidents – Any below
- Suicide Attempt (Medicaid/NIMRS)
- Suicidal Ideation (Medicaid)
- Self-Inflicted Harm/Injury (Medicaid)
- Self-Inflicted Poisoning (Medicaid)

## HARP Status Filter Updated

The “HARP Status” filter in Recipient Search includes the full HARP enrollment and eligibility categories that will be updated weekly as eligible individuals become enrolled in HARP and are assessed for HCBS eligibility. The following “HARP Status” categories will be available in Recipient Search:

- Eligible/Enrolled All (H1-H9)
- Enrolled All (H1-H3)
- Enrolled without HCBS Eligibility (H1)
- Enrolled with Tier 1 HCBS Eligibility (H2)
- Enrolled with Tier 2 HCBS Eligibility (H3)
- SNP HARP-Eligible All (H4-H6)\*
- SNP HARP-Eligible without HCBS Eligibility (H4)\*
- SNP HARP-Eligible with Tier 1 HCBS Eligibility (H5)\*
- SNP HARP-Eligible with Tier 2 HCBS Eligibility (H6)\*
- Eligible Pending Enrollment (H9)
- Not HARP-Eligible (Current Medicaid Enrollees excluding H1-H9)

\*Individuals who meet criteria for one of the SNP filter categories will only be displayed in the Recipient Search results page if the client(s) signed the PSYCKES consent form or in the context of a clinical emergency.

## New Active Medicaid Restrictions Filter

The “Active Medicaid Restrictions” filter in Recipient Search allows users to conduct a group search to identify all recipients who have “Any Medicaid Restriction(s)” or a specific Medicaid restriction, such as a “Pharmacy Restriction” or “Clinic restriction,” for example.

## Diagnostic Search Categories Updated - ICD-10 & DSM-5

The “Behavioral Health (BH) Diagnosis” and “Medical Diagnosis” search filters located in the Recipient Search “Medication & Diagnosis” section incorporate diagnostic records with the ICD-10 (International Classification of Diseases version 10) for physical health conditions and DSM-5 (Diagnostic and Statistical Manual version 5) for behavioral health conditions. ICD-9 and ICD-10 behavioral health diagnoses are linked to DSM-5 diagnostic names. In order to select one or more specific diagnoses within a diagnostic category, click on the “+” icon to the left of the diagnostic category name and the diagnoses within that category will appear. Select the desired diagnostic category or specific diagnosis by clicking on the name; up to 4 can be selected at one time.

## My QI Overview & Statewide Reports

### Additional Program Type Filters

Three additional program type filter options are available in the My QI Overview and Statewide Report filter pages: “Clinic - Medical Specialty (Medical, Mental Health, or Substance Use diagnosis or service),” “Clinic - Unspecified Specialty (Medical, Mental Health, or Substance Use diagnosis or Service),” and “Outpatient - Substance Use.” If applicable, these additional program type categories will allow more recipients to be included in the QI Overview and Statewide Reports.
